Grape variety: Folle blanche

Average age of vineyards: 40 years old

Origin: Monnières

Terroir: Gabbro

Vinification: After an overnight settling, 15-day alcoholic fermentation with indigenous yeasts.

Tasting: This wine has a pale color, with green reflection, typical from this variety. Fresh and nervous, it also reveals mineral notes.

Pairings: Our Gros-Plant "La Part du Colibri" pairs well seafood, and shellfish especially. It goes well with crudités and sushi as well.

Service: Serve fresh, but not too cold (between 8 and 9°C).

Production: Our Gros-Plant du Pays Nantais "La Part du Colibri" is certified organic and Demeter.
