<u>Grape variety:</u> Melon B.

Age of vineyards: 35 years old

<u>Terroir & Origin</u>: metamorphic rocks of gneiss type and volcanic rocks of gabbro type, villages of Monnières and Gorges

<u>Vinification & Aging:</u> light settling overnight, indigenous yeasts, aging on fermentations lees in stainless steel tanks, bottled on March 13th, 2025

<u>Analysis:</u> 11% vol., 0.4 gr/L of residual sugars, 64 mg/L of total SO2

<u>Production</u>: certified in organic and biodynamic agriculture

<u>Tasting</u>: beautiful yellow-green color, young and fruity Muscadet which develops aromas of citrus fruit, well-structured and good minerality

Pairings: for the aperitif, with seafood, starters, sushi

<u>Service:</u> fresh, but not too cold, around 8-9°C

Aging potential: 2-3 years
