

Terre de Gneiss 2020 Muscadet Sèvre et Maine



Grape variety: Melon B.

Age of vineyards: 67 years old

Terroir & Origin: metamorphic rocks of gneiss type, village of Monnières

Harvests: hand-harvested, September 4th, 2020

Vinification & Aging: light settling overnight, indigenous yeasts, aging on fermentation lees in a cement egg, bottled on June 17th, 2021

Analysis: 12.5% vol., < 0.5 gr/L of residual sugars, 37 mg/L of total SO₂

Production: certified in organic and biodynamic agriculture

Tasting: a wine that is long on the palate, well-structured with minerality

Pairings: fish in sauce (beurre blanc), white meat, soft cheese

Service: fresh, around 10-12°C, decant the wine 2h before serving it

Aging potential: 8-10 years
